

## Hailey library to mark Earth Week with digital lecture

The Hailey Public Library has partnered with the Idaho National Laboratory for a series of virtual lectures on the cutting-edge research the latter organization is conducting. The first installment will be held during Earth Week on Thursday, April 23, at 5:30 p.m.
