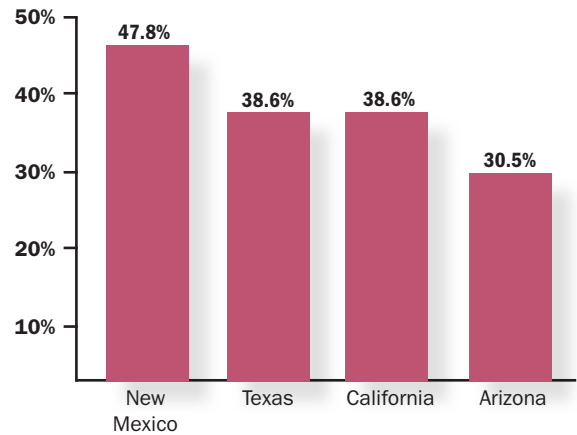

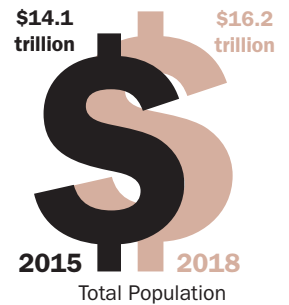
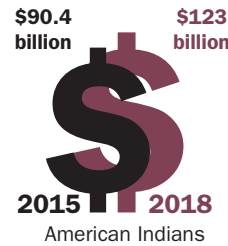
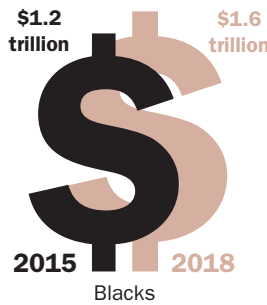
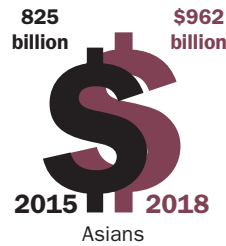
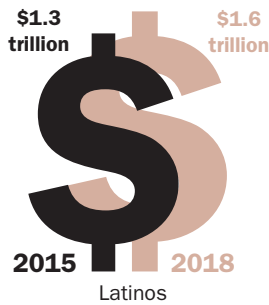


4 States Where 30% or More of the Population are Hispanic

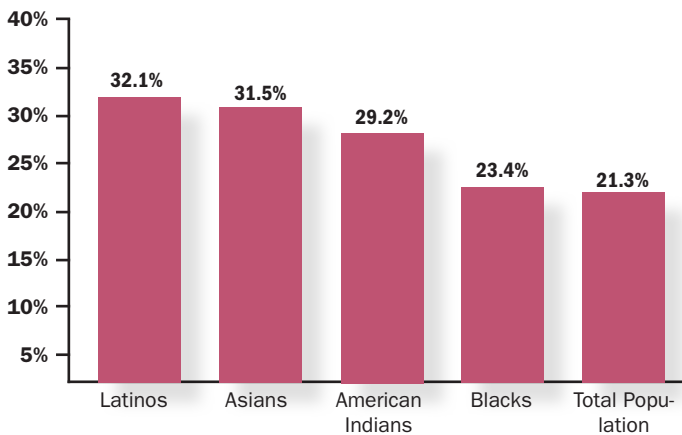

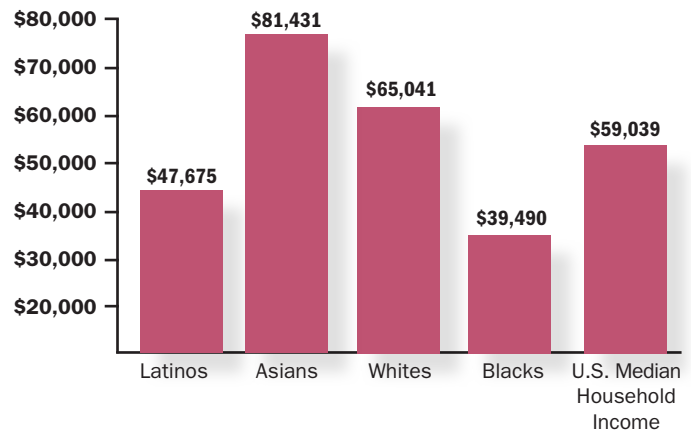

Percent Change in Buying Power (2014-2019)

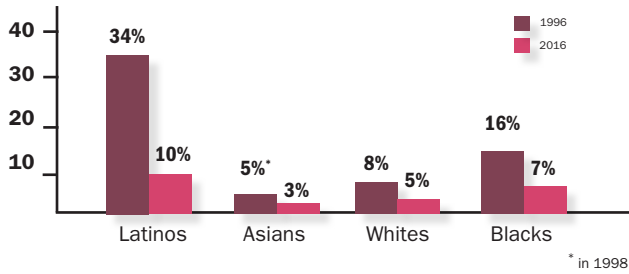


Median Household Income (2016)

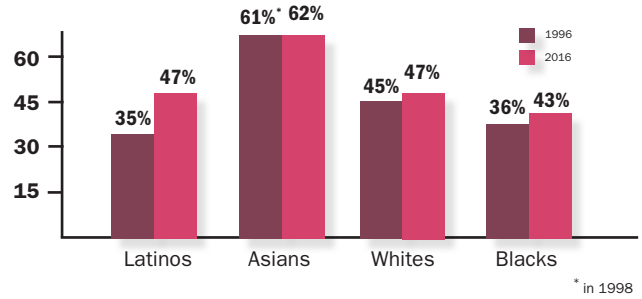
